## **North Tahoe Event Center Begins Rotating Art Exhibits**

(Kings Beach, California) - The North Tahoe Event Center has partnered with North Tahoe Arts and the Art in Public Places program to provide rotating art exhibits available to the public. The Center hopes to provide a more inviting atmosphere through the showing of artwork with a connection to the North Tahoe Community, either through the artist or content of the work. By rotating the artwork, the Center also hopes to provide a reason for members of the community to come to the Center that might not otherwise have a reason to do so.

The current exhibit, Wild Encounters Photography by photographers William Cooper and JoAnn Lippert is a sampling of their photography which focuses on sights, colors and textures of world cultures and primitive tribes including the Wild Animals, Beliefs, Flowers, People, Places and Things that are part of these cultures.

“While the artwork that has been in the Event Center has served us well for many years, working with Art in Public Places allows the North Tahoe Event Center to provide its visitors, as well as the residents of North Tahoe, a new cultural experience” says Kathy Long, Parks and Facilities Manager. “This new partnership also provides local artists a new venue to show off their artwork and connect with a segment of the community that may not have previously been aware of their work.”

The Event Center has removed a number of the older tapestries in the main foyer that had been hanging since the remodeling of the Center to provide space for the new art displays. Additional space will be made as finances to repair walls, remove wallpaper and repaint are available.

The public is invited to come into the Center during normal business hours to view the art on display at no charge. Exhibits will be rotated approximately every 3 months.
